Anne has been involved with the community based sector in early childhood as a teacher, kindergarten committee member, advocate and currently as chairperson of Community Child Care Victoria.

Nicole Pilsworth is an early childhood educator and has been working in Children's Services for the past 20 years. She has worked in a variety of child care and kindergarten settings in both NSW and Victoria. More recently she has been employed as a TAFE teacher and early childhood trainer. Nicole currently works in local government as an early childhood development professional working with staff on the implementation of the new Curriculum Frameworks and National Reform Agenda. Nicole is a Board member of KPV, a member of ECA and a strong advocate for the rights of young children.

Quality Area 2: Children's Health and Safety

Presenter Glenda Glover is a qualified early childhood educator with many years teaching experience in a range of early childhood education settings. Since joining the advisory team at KPV, Glenda has been involved in writing many of KPV's resources and specialises in the area of governance. She has considerable experience delivering training to committees of management in governance, facilitating seminars and conference sessions and represents KPV and its members at a range of forums and advisory groups.

Quality Area 3: Physical Environment

Presenter Zora Marko was the Project Co-ordinator of the KPV OHS Champions Project funded by WorkSafe Victoria from 2008 to 2011 to improve the OHS experience of early childhood services in Victoria. The project produced a range of OHS resources specifically targeted to children's services, including the popular early childhood OHS website www.ohsinecservices.org.au. Zora has a Diploma in Occupational Health and Safety and over 20 years' experience in industrial relations. She has a keen interest in occupational health and safety and supporting the sector to find solutions to make the workplace safer.

Quality Area 4: Staffing Arrangements

Presenter David Haesler has been an adviser with KPV since January 1995 and specialises in the area of payroll and industrial relations. He has been involved as part of the KPV team negotiating industrial agreements for the sector. 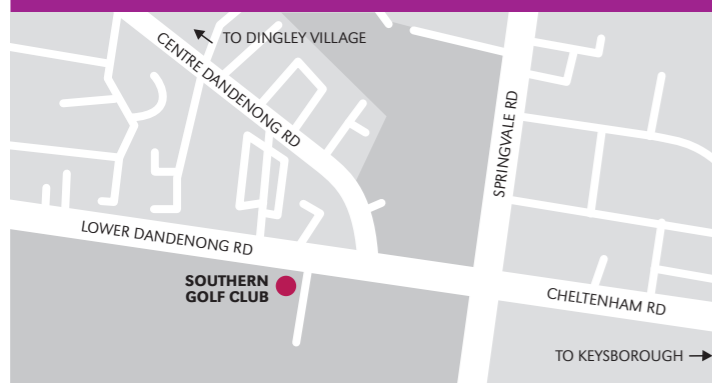

Corner of Springvale Rd and Lower Dandenong Rd, Keysborough



Parking The Southern Golf Club offers unrestricted parking in the front car park.

Bus From the Springvale Railway Station (Springvale) walk 5 minutes to the Springvale Shopping Centre/Springvale Rd (Springvale). Take the Route 902 bus towards Chelsea. Get off at stop Southpark Cl/Springvale Rd (Keysborough) near the corner of lower Dandenong Rd. Then walk to Southern Golf Club.

Parking is available at the Watts St car park (multi story) opposite the Town Hall. Parking rates are \$1.20 per hour or \$5.00 all day

Train There is public transport to Box Hill by train, the Box Hill train station is approximately a 6 minute walk to the Town Hall.
